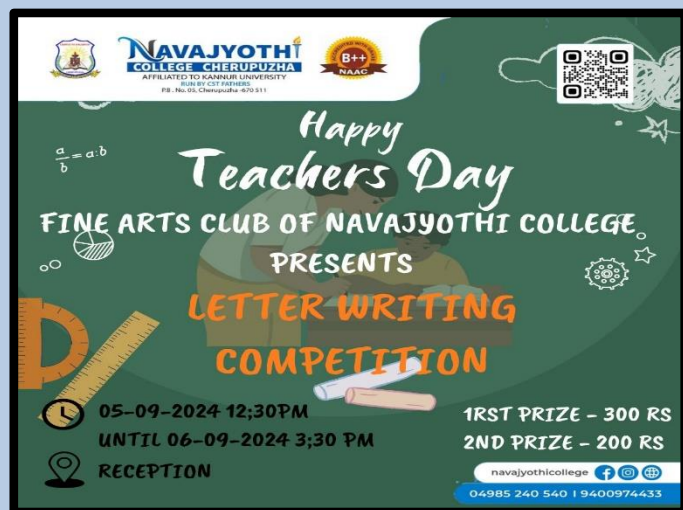
## Letter writing competition

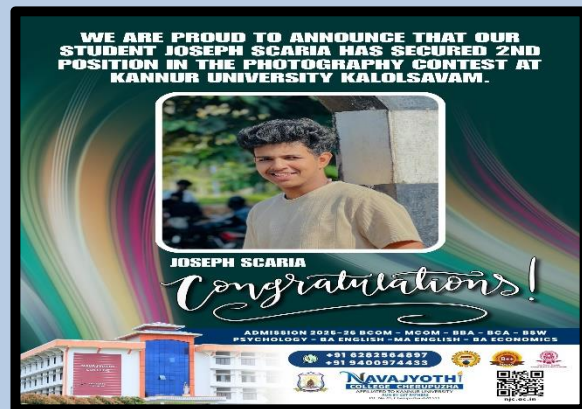
