


#### **Academic Performance Overview**

#### **AUDIO BOOK COMPETITION (INTERCOLLEGIATE)**




Association of PG Department of English conducted an intercollegiate audio book competition as part of national reading day celebration in the month of June. It was held online with the due date of

from Muhammed Minhaj, third-year BA English student. Total 22 students participated in the programme. The session was informative, engaging, and highly beneficial for the students.



ASSOCIATION 2024-2025 <u>CINEMAX</u>












# **Author Meet (Author's Day Observation)**






